

Finalised F3A Team selection process for 2008/09

- All 2008/2009 team selection events will consist of four rounds (P-09, F-09, P-09, F-09) with the best three normalised scores to count.
- No fly-offs will be flown
- Pilots not wishing to compete for team selection will be allowed to fly four rounds of the P-09 schedule and trophies will also be awarded for this category.
- F3A Pilots are required to clearly indicate on the entry form if they wish to compete in team selection process or not.
- The National champion and Masters champion will be decided out of the pilots that elect to participate in the team selection process.
- In order to be eligible for team selection a pilot must have competed in at least two team selection events.
- Two of the three mentioned team selection events will count towards the final team selection for participating pilots.
- Pilots must have qualified for an invite to the 2008 Masters to remain part of the team selection process even though for some valid reason they are not able to participate in the event.
- The organisers of monthly, league and provincials events can determine in agreement with participating F3A pilots if P-09 schedules only or both P-09 & F09 schedules are flown at these events.
- All monthly, league and provincials events will consist of four rounds of the P schedule or individual pilots could indicate to the organisers that they will fly both the P-09 & F09 schedules at the respective competition.

The above proposed team selection criteria will be implemented with effect from 8 February 2008, leaving sufficient preparation time for the 2008 Nationals.

Please circulate and discuss this notification with any current or potential competing F3A pilots that have not been involved in the finalisation of the 2008/09 F3A team selection process.
