APPLICABILITY

100.01.1

This Part shall apply to the operation of line-controlled kites, model aircraft, and captive and unmanned free balloons, and contains -

- (a) in addition to the provisions of Part 91, the operating and flight rules relating to such operations; and
- (b) the exceptions to the general operating and flight rules prescribed in Part 91.

CONDITIONS FOR FLIGHT: LINE CONTROLLED KITS

101.01.2

No line-controlled kite shall be flown –

- (a) by night;
- (b) higher than 150 feet above the surface;
- (c) from or above a public road; or
- (d) on the approaches to any aerodrome licensed or approved in terms of Part 139 of the Regulations;

unless with the written approval of the Commissioner, and on conditions determined by him or her.

CONDITIONS FOR FLIGHT: MODEL AIRCRAFT

101.01.3

- (1) No model aircraft shall be flown –

- (a) by night;
 - (b) higher than 150 feet above the surface;
 - (c) from or above a public road; or
 - (d) within a distance of 8 kilometre from the aerodrome reference point of an aerodrome licensed or approved in terms of Part 139 of the Regulations and situated in Class G airspace.
- (2) Notwithstanding the provisions of sub-regulation (1), the Commissioner may approve in writing, and on conditions determined by him or her –
- (a) exempt anyone from the provisions of paragraph (1)(d);
- and
- (b) exempt anyone from the provisions of paragraphs (1)(a), (b) and (c) in airspace specifically approved by the Commissioner for the purpose of flying model aircraft.

CONDITIONS FOR FLIGHT: Captive Balloons

101.01.4

- (1) No captive-balloon operation shall be conducted --
- (a) by night;
 - (b) higher than 150 feet above the surface;
 - (c) from or above a public road; or
 - (d) less than 8 kilometre from the aerodrome reference point of an aerodrome licensed or approved in terms of Part 139 of the Regulations;

unless with the prior written approval of the Commissioner, and on conditions determined by him or her.

CONDITIONS FOR FLIGHT: UNMANNED FREE BALLOONS

101.01.5

- (1) No unmanned free-balloon operation shall take place without the prior written permission of the Commissioner and on the conditions determined by him or her.
- (2) For the purposes of this regulation, the mass-release of toy balloons shall be considered to be the launch of an unmanned free balloon.
