

Fun Fly COVID-19 Management Plan

1. The local flying club must have an approved Certificate of Compliance from SAMAA.
 - a. These rules are to be adhered to when flying the rounds.
2. A compliance officer must be present when flying the rounds.
3. Participants are to adhere to proper social distancing.
4. Marshals / fun fly co-ordinators are not to share any equipment (pens, clipboards, timing devices etc).
5. Regular hand sanitising is encouraged.
6. All the event equipment, where applicable, to be sanitised before flying starts and once the flying is finished.
7. Club Covid-19 measures to be included in the pilots briefing before flying commences.
8. Non-compliance by a competitor will result in a warning, after which the competitor will be banned from flying for that round (round 1, 2 or 3)
9. A detailed logbook will be kept per round to ensure that contact tracing can take place, should a competitor, marshal / official test positive.
10. Helpers must to be fellow competitors, or in the case of junior competitors, one immediate family member only if required.
11. No members of the public will be allowed.

In addition, for the Masters:

1. The Masters will be subject to Alert Level travel limitations
2. The hosting club COVID-19 plan will be followed
3. A Maximum of 20 competitors will be invited to participate in the Masters, with a maximum of 50 people permitted on site, including competitors, helpers, judges, marshals, organisers and journalists/photographers. Please note no spectators, family or members of the public are permitted.
4. Competitors, marshals / officials to adhere to social distancing
