## MAASA Competition COVID-19 Safety plan – 14 July 2020

### General

- SAMAA to be informed of competition and venue as well as expected turnout prior to event.
- Hosting club's plan to be adhered to at all times for the duration of the event.
- Copy of hosting club COVID-19 plan to be posted at the venue together with this plan.
- Maximum number of competitors and officials to be limited to the number specified by the hosting club COVID-19 plan but in any event not more than 25 people. Any deviation required from this ruling will carry SAMAA and hosting club approval.
- No visitors allowed.
- A COVID Compliance Officer to be appointed for the day responsible for monitoring compliance with the COVID plan. The compliance officer should be a representative of the provincial MAASA committee or, failing which, the provincial MAASA representative.
- Sanitizing Gel/Liquid (minimum 70% alcohol) to be made available at the venue for the duration of the event. To be used by all people on arrival and regularly during the course of the competition.
- Spray bottle with bleach solution to be made available for sanitizing equipment.
- As far as possible competitors, helpers and officials should bring their own sanitizing gel/liquid and/or bleach solution.
- All temperatures to be taken with non contact thermal digital thermometer (< 37.5degC)
- A MAASA Covid-19 register to be completed for all people attending the event. A clear copy to be emailed to [secretary@maasa.co.za](mailto:secretary@maasa.co.za) after the event and copy emailed to [samaa-admin@mweb.co.za](mailto:samaa-admin@mweb.co.za) for attention Linda Dold.
- Physical distancing rules (minimum 1.5m) to be adhered to at all times. This includes pilots, model airplanes, equipment, helpers and officials.
- Masks to be worn at all times and by all participants for the duration of the event.
- Pilots briefing will reiterate Covid 19 measures and precautions for each event.

### **Judging**

- Judges to bring own chairs and pens.
- Spacing between judges of 2m as per sporting code.
- No scribes allowed for judges.
- Judges to sanitize their hands and equipment before and after their judging slot.
- If electronic devices are used for scoring they must be sanitized before use by each judging panel.
- If paper score sheets are used only 1 scorer is permitted to handle the completed sheets and must sanitise before and after capturing.

### **Pilots and Callers**

- Callers to maintain 1.5m distance from Pilot. Callers spot to be clearly marked.
- Helper carrying the model from/to the flight line must sanitize before and after.
- Call cards may not be shared.
- Pilot and caller and helpers must sanitize before and after each flight.

### **Prize Giving**

- Everyone present at prize giving to respect social distancing.
- Medals to be sanitized before prize giving.
- No handshaking and no handing over of medals.

### **Catering**


- No food or drinks will be provided by the organizers. Individuals to cater for themselves.

### **Positive Test**

- If any member, within a two week period after the competition, is tested as being Covid positive, the club chairman, SAMAA and all competitors will be alerted.

### **Breach**

- It is the duty of our elected Compliance Officer for the day to enforce members' compliance with these rules.
- The Compliance Officer on duty has the authority to discipline any member breaching these rules.
- Any member found in breach of these rules will be given a verbal and written warning.
- If such breach occurs a second time the member will immediately be requested to leave the event.
